 - For voluntary groups outside Scotland and public sector organisations
- **Individual Member - £7.00 per annum**
 - For individuals who would like to benefit from SLCVO membership

NB: Associate and Individual members have access to most member benefits but have no voting rights, nor can they stand for election to the Management Board.

Data protection

Skye and Lochalsh CVO Members Database

As a member of Skye and Lochalsh CVO your contact details will be recorded in our members database. Personal data (name, address and contact information) will not be disclosed to third parties without prior permission. You will receive member mailings, email briefings and from time to time updates on the range of services available to SLCVO members.

Milo Third Sector Database

Milo is the national database for third sector interfaces across Scotland. As a partner in the Highland Third Sector Interface Skye and Lochalsh CVO use the Milo database to manage and publish volunteering opportunities, record community group contact details and information about their activity, monitor the services we provide and contribute to national monitoring of the TSI network by the Scottish Government.

The information provided on your application form will be entered onto Milo and used to monitor and improve the quality of our service, as well as to carry out local and national research on the third sector.

Any personal information you provide (e.g. the name, personal email or home address of a main contact) will be held and used in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. If you do not wish for your personal information to be held on Milo please indicate on your application. Personal information held on Milo will not be disclosed to any unauthorised person or body without your permission.

Only authorised Milo users will have access to all of the information you supply. In the case of specific interactions with Skye and Lochalsh CVO staff, details will not be shared outside the Highland TSI.

General organisational information will be made available to other organisations and the public through approved local and national websites (such as www.volunteerscotland.org.uk). We will not display personal contact names or information unless you give us permission to do so.

Anonymised statistical data gathered from our database may be used to report to our various funders.
